Wave Hub is an offshore electrical facility to allow connection of Wave Energy Converters (WEC's) to the National Grid, located c 10nm off St Ives Head, north Cornwall. The contract comprises the design manufacture and supply of a main sub sea power cable, associated terminations and cable fittings along with shorter ancillary cables. The cable is anticipated to be double armoured 6-core x 300mm² x 33kV x 26,500m power cable (approximate length). There is also a requirement for Fabrication of the Wave Hub (a subsea enclosure rated for 100m WD, and containing busbar assemblies, cable connections, fibre optic connections and enclosure penetrators/connectors)

Fabrication of a protection structure for the Wave Hub including mud mat foundations and lifting eyes.

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SWRDA will incorporate a minimum 10 calendar day standstill period at the point information on the award of the contract is communciated to candidates.
